Busker Auditions will be held on Wednesday, Feb. 26, from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the PACE Center. Please prepare a 30 second to one minute sample of your talent for the audition. **You will be responsible for your own costume, equipment, props, and instruments.** Performances may be of Elizabethan or other historical periods, but they should not include modern music.
