- **Three or more Alcohol Inks- one or the other brand. Choose your favorite colors. Include one metallic Alcohol Ink, if possible.**
 - Ranger Ink - Tim Holtz - Alcohol Inks These come in sets of three and can be found at Michaels, Hobby Lobby, Joann Fabrics or Amazon. Note that it's much easier to read the color on the labels of the alcohol inks found at Hobby Lobby even though the same brand can be found elsewhere.
 - Jacquard Pinata - These come as individual bottles and can be found at Guirys or Amazon.

- **Other Items to be provided by Student:**
 - **91% Isopropyl Alcohol.** Can be found in the pharmacy section of Walgreens or any grocery store. **Please pour some in a small bottle with a pointed tip.**
 - Note pad and pen/pencil for taking notes
 - Smock or old clothes that can get messy. The ink does not come out of clothes.
 - \$3.00 supply fee to instructor for ceramic tiles and shared supplies

- **Optional Items that may be provided by student:**
 - Alcohol Ink Clean Up Solution
 - Canned Air
 - Cosmetic sponges
 - Alcohol Swabs in individual packs
 - Artist Pens or Sharpie/Copic Markers
